

Altar Care Ministry

The Altar Care Ministry is responsible for laundering the purificators, the corporals, and the towels. It also cleans both the chapel altar and the altar in the church. Several times a year the alter server robes are laundered. At Easter time, the towels used for washing of the feet are laundered. Any clothes which are stained are taken to be professionally cleaned.

The time commitment is a couple of hours a week. We operate on a month-by-month schedule. Two persons are responsible for one month. They decide who will work for a two-week period in their assigned month. The soiled linens are picked up each week after all the Masses on Sunday or Monday. Each minister is scheduled for approximately two months during the calendar year. No one is assigned to two months in a row. There are no meetings. The ministry head instructs new members. New members are needed and welcomed.

The goal is to always keep the altar clean and to provide clean purificators, carpals, and towels each week.
